Basic Lay Servant – Mrs. Cheryl Denley – Required course before taking an advanced class. Basic LS is for the lay person to learn the ABC's of the United Methodist Church and better prepare her/himself for leadership.

Advance Course #1 Lay Servants Lead in Conflict Resolution – Rev. Daniel Herring – Explores different ways of dealing with constructive ways of resolving conflict.
